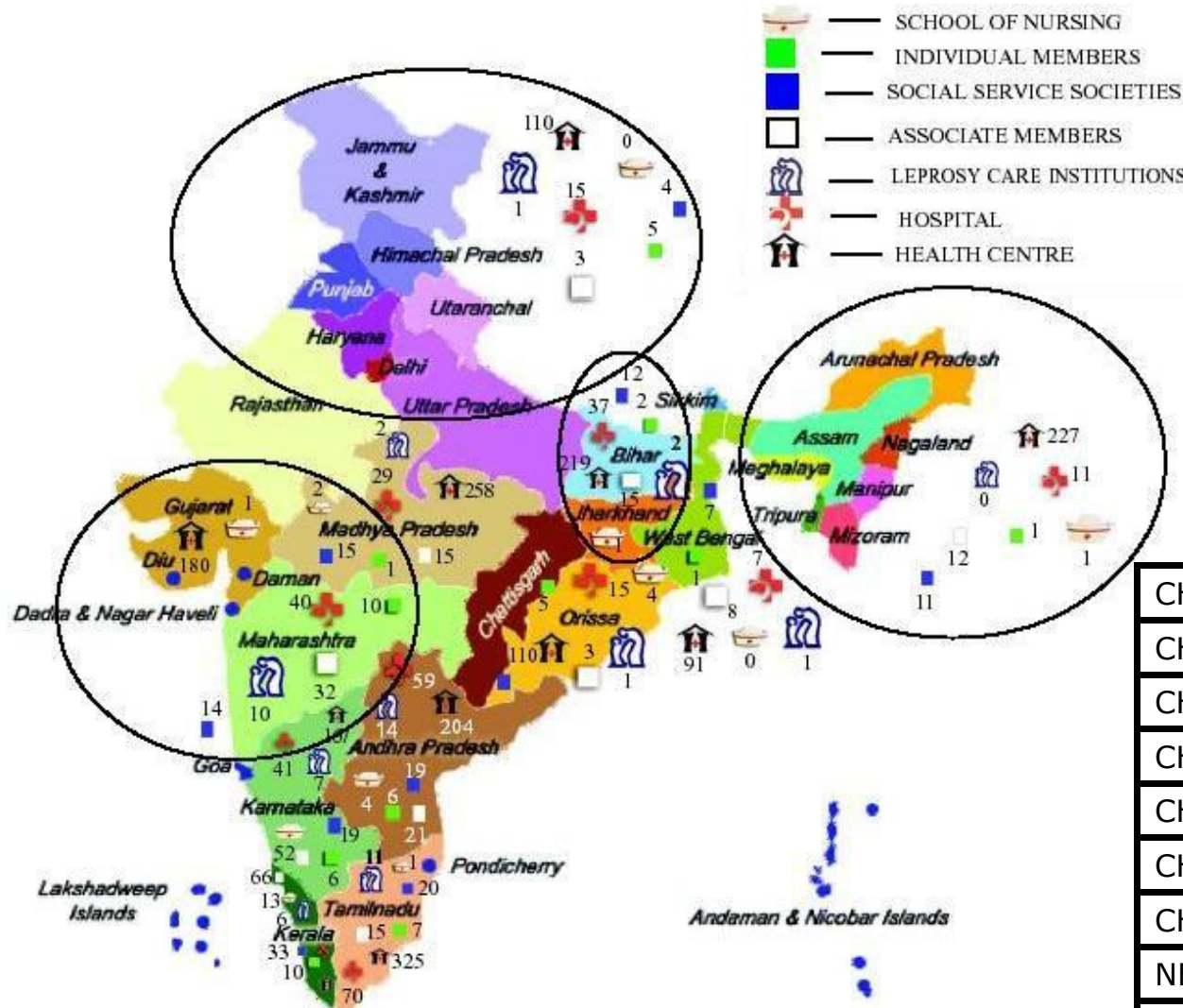

Challenges

- Minimal availability of services in the remotest areas of CHAI operations
- Indifferent attitude of few staff in govt. in few places in building collaborations in service delivery
- Delayed acceptance of proposals for linkages with government in few districts
- Payments to the existing schemes getting delayed in few places thus breakage in linkages and institutions going on their own in service delivery
