CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR TB CHAMPION AWARD (ORGANIZATION)

Tuberculosis is one of India's greatest public health challenges. India has the highest burden of TB in the world, accounting for one-fourth of the global incidence – 2.3 million cases annually. There are countless efforts and actions taken by many organizations and individuals to fight TB and empower affected communities across the country, but these often go unrecognized and TB occupies a limited space in the public imagination.

The Partnership for TB Care and Control and Global Health Strategies is pleased to announce an annual award for TB Champions in India to recognise and honour the achievements of organizations committed to working on critical issues around TB in India.

The first call for applications for the TB Champion Award (Organization) is issued by the Partnership for TB Care and Control in India and Global Health Strategies to recognize the extraordinary efforts of organizations working for tuberculosis care and control in India.

A cash prize of 50,000 INR for the winning organization is supported by Global Health Strategies. The prize is awarded annually to institutions or organizations that have made a significant contribution to the fight against TB in India.

This is an application only category, and there is no facility for nomination. All non-governmental organizations and institutions working for TB Care and Control registered in India are eligible to apply. All applications will be screened and reviewed by the selection committee.

The winner of The Partnership Award for TB Champion (Organization) will be announced at the 4th National Consultative Meeting of the Partnership in January 2013 at New Delhi, India.

The last date for receiving applications is 30 November 2012.
