Other related activity:

Follow up visits were conducted by Ms Vandana Mishra, Program Coordinator during the month of January 2012. She met with about 40 Traditional Healers in the project

area of Block- Nawabganj, district- Unnao. During the meeting, she has boosted up the morale of Traditional Healers and kept on convincing them to send more suspected TB patients to the DMC- Nawabganj, district- Unnao. They have also been motivated to keep on follow up of the TB patients in their area to continue the treatment till the completion of its full course of treatment.

It was found during the follow- up visit, there was one patient got tested in neighbouring DMC of Sarojaninagar, district- Lucknow. It was not included in abovementioned figure in the Report.

The Monitoring Team has come for the field level monitoring of the project during the period of 30th and 31st January, 2012 in district- Unnao. The Team was comprises of Dr Vianca Laloo, Technical Officer, The Union and Smt. Sunita Prasad, Consultant- MDC- TB & CSR, Eli Lilly & Co. (India) Pvt. Ltd. from New Delhi.

During the field monitoring, the Team has visited many places viz. Soharamau, Saharavan, Nawabganj, Ajgain, etc. and met with many trained Traditional Healers, their patients, Medical Officer, STS, LT, DTO, and other population. The team has also verified the data and progress of the project from the MIS and open discussion with different stakeholders. The Program Coordinator, Mrs Vandana Mishra has facilitated the team during the visit for their interaction, feedback and verification. Dr SK Srivastava, Director- SIR, Shri STH Zaidi, Consultant, Shri Manoj K Tiwari, Consultant, Shri PK Singh, Coordinator, etc. of SIR were also visited the project area and interacted with different stakeholders.

The contribution of Traditional Healers was found satisfactory and encouraging. The referral of TB suspect found increased remarkably. The regular follow up and meeting of Traditional Healers in October month seems useful for the project.
