Other related activity:

Meeting of Traditional Healers about the implementation of ‘Training of Traditional Healers’ in Unnao (U.P.) under Eli Lilly Project Intervention 3, has been organised on

22.10.2011 at 11.30 AM at the Clinic of Dr Sushil Kumar, Jaitipur in Block-Nawabganj, district- Unnao. The meeting was organised to boost up the morale of Traditional Healers in the area so that the referral rate could be increased. There were total 15 Traditional Healers were present in the meeting. During the meeting, all Traditional Healers explained their contribution to the program and the referrals made by them after attending the Sensitisation Program. Some of Traditional Healers also share their difficulty regarding the less support from the concerned staff of DMC, Nawabganj, Unnao. All of them found the need of getting more knowledge regarding the TB and its treatment related information from the qualified Doctors. Some of them have shown their interest to become the DOTS Provider in future.

All the problems were noted down and they were motivated to increase the referral for testing and follow up to complete the treatment till the full course. The meeting was held informally without pre-determined schedule, just to improve the impact of the program by the internal support and resources of SIR.

The referral rate and detection of TB patients were found increasing. During the meeting, they were demanding to organise regular monthly meeting to share the experience and learning of the project. They were informed that Re-Sensitisation Program for Traditional Healers would be organised soon.

After getting the feedback from the Traditional Healers, during the meeting in group and individual, while conducting follow-up visits in different parts of the Block-Nawabganj, district- Unnao. The Program Coordinator Mrs Vandana Mishra met with DTO, Unnao, Shri Rakesh Kumar, and explained the hurdles and requested him to ensure the support to the program. He assured and instructed the concerned CMS of PHC, Nawabganj, Unnao to extend full support to the program. He also directed concerned STS (Shri SK Mishra) to take care of patients and control the non-cooperating staff. The proper intervention of DTO and CMS through STS has improved the services and staff attitudes and the staff started behaving in normal and positive manner with them.
